RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Accept resignations of six members of the Arts Commission

BACKGROUND and SUMMARY

A combination of philosophical differences among Arts Commission members and a pervasive feeling that the Arts Commission was unable to achieve many of its long-term goals for a variety of reasons resulted in the submittal of resignations from six of its eleven members during September and October 2007.

The members who submitted their resignations include:

- **Leslie Allen**, voting member with a term that was scheduled to extend through January 2010
- **Steefenie Wicks**, voting member with a term that was scheduled to extend through January 2008
- **Thomas Roedoc**, voting member with a term that was scheduled to extend through January 2009
- **Victor Fisher**, voting member with a term that was scheduled to extend through January 2010
- **Suzie Buchholz**, Advisory Member (no specification of term)
- **Stuart Sheldon**, Advisory Member (no specification of term)

ISSUES

The City Council should accept the resignations of these members through formal action on its Consent Calendar.

The City Manager is directing discussion of goals and objectives of the Arts Commission so that it may re-form as a strong working group. Meanwhile, staff is accepting applications from interested parties who wish to be considered for appointment to the group by the City Council. The voting member seats require residency within the Sausalito city limits, while the Advisory Member seats do not require residency but do require that those members be active in the arts and/or in the business of arts in the community.
