ADDENDUM NO. 1

to the

SPECIFICATIONS AND BID DOCUMENTS

for the construction of

2013 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The purpose of this addendum is to:

- Revise the language on the Safety Qualification Criteria form in the Bid Proposal concerning the EMR;
- Add a bid item and associated special provision language to cover potential replacement of storm drains along Richardson Street. Since the condition of these existing storm drain pipes is unknown, the work is being included as supplemental work. Please note that the Base Bid Forms have been updated to include this additional bid item;
- Modify the door flyer to include a reference to the project's Measure A funding;
- Notify the bidder of recent information obtained on the PG&E gas line on Richardson Street;
- Specify that the work on Coloma Street must be completed on or prior to August 9th, 2013 or penalties will be assessed; and
- Add a **SPECIAL NOTICE** concerning the payment of temporary and permanent traffic stripes.

The following **SPECIAL NOTICE** is provided for informational purposes only and shall not be considered a part of the contract:

Payment for Temporary and Permanent Striping and Pavement Markings

Attention is directed to Section 84-1.04 of these Special Provisions concerning the payment for all temporary and permanent traffic stripes and pavement markings. They are considered as included in the various contract items of work and no separate payment will be made therefor.

The **SPECIFICATIONS AND BID DOCUMENTS** are amended as follows:

Pages 10 and 11 of the BID PROPOSAL, which contain the Base Bid Forms, are replaced with the following attached Pages 10A and 11A.

Page 25 of the BID PROPOSAL, which contains the Safety Qualification Criteria form, is replaced with the following attached Page 25A.

Add to Section 7-1.03:

Bright yellow door hangers as described in this section shall include--in addition to what is described in condition #3--the following information:

Supported with Marin County Measure A Funds
Your Measure A Sales Tax Dollars at Work

With the exception of towing, full compensation for complying with this section shall be considered as included in the contract price paid for Mobilization, and no separate payment will be made therefor.

Add Section 8-1.10C:

Complete all work on Coloma Street on or prior to August 9th, 2013. Failure to meet this deadline will result in damages of \$2,000 per day being assessed and deducted from your payments.

Add to Section 12-2.01:

Portable funding signs must be placed on each street that is under construction activities that day.

Add to Section 15-1.01:

Be cognizant that the existing PG&E gas line and associated laterals were recently found by another contractor to be as shallow as 10-inches below existing grade on Richardson. Coordinate with PG&E prior to start of construction to understand what protection and/or mitigation measures are necessary.

Add to Section 65-2.03A:

The condition of the existing storm drain mainline along Richardson Street is not believed to need repair. However other small sections of storm drain connecting inlets to the main line or serving as cross-street cross-drains may require replacement.

Review and assess the condition of the existing storm drains during roadway excavation activities on Richardson Street. Immediately bring any damaged or deteriorated storm drains to the Engineer's attention. Replace with 18-inch RCP as directed by the Engineer.

Connection of new pipe to existing structures is considered as included in the price per linear foot for Supplemental Work (18-inch Class III RCP) and no separate payment will be made therefor. It is assumed that connection work will consist of minor modifications to existing structures, including removal of a portion of the structure to permit connection to the new pipe and concrete collars. Should replacement of a structure be necessary it will be paid for as extra work.

Bidder must acknowledge receipt of this Addendum. Acknowledgment must be shown in the space provided below and returned with the Bid Proposal prior to the date and hour set for the opening of bids, 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 23, 2013.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all Bids and to waive any and all irregularities and informalities in Bids not involving price, time or changes in the Work. The City reserves the right to reject any nonconforming, nonresponsive, incomplete, unbalanced or conditional Bids.

In case of discrepancy between the unit price and the line item cost set forth for a unit price item, the unit price shall prevail and, shall be utilized as the basis for determining the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. However, if the amount set forth as a unit price is ambiguous, unintelligible or uncertain for any cause, or is omitted, or is the same amount as the entry in the "Item Cost" column, then the amount set forth in the "Item Cost" column for the item shall prevail and shall be divided by the estimated quantity for the item and the price thus obtained shall be the unit price. Discrepancies between the indicated sum of any column of figures and the correct sum thereof will be resolved in favor of the correct sum. Discrepancies between bid amounts stated in words and in figures will be resolved in favor of the amount stated in words. Final payment shall be determined by the Engineer from measured quantities of work performed based upon the unit price.

If the contract is to be awarded, it will be awarded to responsible Bidder that submits the lowest responsive bid. **City of Sausalito will determine the lowest bid on the basis of the grand total of the base bid Schedule Plus alternate bid schedule.**

SAFETY QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

The following information will be used to determine if the bidder meets the minimum safety requirements for this Project. To qualify to bid and be awarded the Project, the Contractor's three year average Workers' Compensation Experience Modification (EMR) must not be greater than 1.1 (110%). The Bidder shall list its Experience Modification Rate for the last three (3) complete years (available from your insurance carrier).

If the Bidder's EMR is greater than 1.1 (110%) contractor may include an explanation of the factors that elevated its EMR. The City will evaluate that information as part of its determination of the Bidder's responsibility for purposes of the award of the contract.
