NOTICE OF ELECTION
NOTICE OF MEASURE TO BE VOTED ON

By authority of Resolution No. 5536, adopted by the Sausalito City Council on August 4, 2015, **NOTICE** is hereby given that the following described Measure is to be voted on at the Special Election to be held in the City of Sausalito on November 3, 2015. The Special Election is to be consolidated with the Uniform District Election to be held that same date. The Measure reads:

“City of Sausalito No-Tax-Increase Park Improvement/Safety Measure. To bring Robin Sweeny Park, Southview Park, Dunphy Park and the MLK site to current health/safety standards; repair unsafe children’s playground equipment, upgrade safety lighting, pathways and play courts; add needed restrooms; restore wetlands/natural areas, shall the City of Sausalito enter into an agreement with the Sausalito Financing Authority and permit revenue from the MLK site to be used as revenue financing, with no increase in taxes?”

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that that direct arguments for or against the measure shall not exceed 300 words in length and shall be submitted to the City Clerk’s office, 420 Litho Street, Sausalito, California, not later than 3:00 p.m. on Monday, August 17, 2015.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that direct arguments for or against said measure may be changed or withdrawn prior to and including August 17, 2015, and that, when the City Clerk has selected the direct arguments for and against said measure, which will be printed and distributed to the voters, the City Clerk shall send a copy of the argument in favor to the authors of the argument against and a copy of the argument against to the authors of the argument in favor. The authors may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not exceeding 250 words. Rebuttal arguments must be filed with the City Clerk no later than 3:00 p.m. on Monday, August 24, 2015. All arguments must be submitted with a verification form and with no more than five (5) signatures.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that Resolution No. 5536, the Impartial Analysis of said Measure, and any direct and rebuttal arguments filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the City Clerk’s office for not less than 10-calendar days from the date of the filing deadlines for each.

The polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
