Special Election Information

The City Clerk's Office is reminding the Sausalito community of this year's November 3, 2015 Special Election.

Sausalito voters will have two items on their local ballot:

- Southern Marin Fire Protection District Directors
- Measure F: Sausalito Park Improvement/Safety Measure

There are three seats up for the election for the Board of Directors for the Southern Marin Fire Protection District, each with a four year term. Please refer to your sample ballot for the candidates for the Board of Directors.

Sausalito's Measure F is the "No-Tax-Increase Park Improvement/Safety Measure". Please find the official Measure F ballot question below:

To bring Robin Sweeny Park, Southview Park, Dunphy Park and the MLK site to current health/safety standards; repair unsafe children's playground equipment, upgrade safety lighting, pathways and play courts, add needed restrooms; restore wetlands/natural areas, shall the City of Sausalito enter into an agreement with the Sausalito Financing Authority and permit revenue from the MLK site to be used as revenue financing, with no increase in taxes?
