1. MONSEF RESIDENCE / 60 RODEO AVENUE – (DR/EA 14-103)

DESCRIPTION: Mike Monsef is requesting approval of a Design Review Permit to construct an approximately 2,600 square foot single-family residence at 60 Rodeo Avenue and recommendation for City Council approval of an Encroachment Agreement for the existing parking deck and steps located in the public right-of-way. DESCRIPTION: In September 1997, the <u>Sausalito Downtown Shared Parking Model</u> was prepared. The model has been updated to accurately estimate parking demand in the downtown area. Sausalito Municipal Code (SMC) Section 10.40.110.G.1 references the 1997 report. A Zoning Ordinance Amendment is proposed to update the SMC to reference the most recent report prepared in 2015.
