NORTH-DIANA RESIDENCE – 25 GLEN COURT (DR-NC 15-302)
OXB Studio Architects – Applicant
Richard North and Elisabeth Diana – Property Owners

DESCRIPTION: OXB Studio Architects, on behalf of Richard North and Elisabeth Diana, is requesting approval of a Design Review Permit for an addition at 25 Glen Court including a 436 square foot second-level for a master bedroom and additional interior modifications; and an approval of a Non-Conformity Permit to continue the existing non-conforming parking spaces located in the garage.

PROJECT: Review draft 50-year memorandum evaluating historical significance of the proposed project.

Board Member LeBaron provided a summary of the draft 50-year review memorandum.

The HLB reviewed the packet of materials for the project and evaluated the historic significance of the existing site and structure(s) on the property.

The HLB concluded their review by stating that based upon the information available and presented, <u>the existing site and structure(s)</u> of the property are not considered to be a significant <u>local historic resource</u>. As such, the HLB made the following findings:

1. Is the structure associated with events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of the history, culture, or heritage of Sausalito, California, or the United States? Such structures may include but are not limited to civic structures, properties featured in publications, and sites where significant events occurred.

The Board finds *no significance* under this criterion. Vote: 3-0.

Is this structure associated with the life or lives of one or more people important in our past? Such structures may include but are not limited to homes of prominent persons and places referenced by prominent persons.

The Board finds no significance under this criterion. Vote: 3-0.

3. Does the structure embody the distinctive characteristics of a type, period, region, or method of construction, or represent the work of an important creative individual, or possess high artistic values? Such structures may include but are not limited to exceptional examples of architecture or an architect's work; more ordinary examples of such work are emblematic of a particular style or era; and any works by prominent creative individuals.

The Board finds <u>moderate significance</u> for distinctive craftsmen characteristics under this criterion. Vote: 3-0.

4. Has the structure yielded, or may it be likely to yield, information important in prehistory or history? Such structures may include but are not limited to archeological sites.

The Board finds *no significance* under this criterion. Vote: 3-0.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Acting Chair Mercado moved and Board Member Richardson seconded a motion to move the approval of the minutes of the November 5, 2015 meeting minutes as submitted by Staff to the next scheduled Historic Landmarks Board meeting. Vote: 3-0.
