





Bulkhead - Financing Agreement between City and Sausalito Yacht Harbor - \$6 million

Robin Sweeny Park Improvement Project Design Review Permit DR-15-175 Sausalito Planning Commission -- July 29, 2015 Resolution No. 2015-18.

Notice Inviting Bids and plans and specifications for the Project posted on the City's website on November 13, 2015.

Project broken into base bid and bid alternate elements in order to ensure that the Council would have as much flexibility as possible in delivering both the Robin Sweeny Park improvements desired by the community, as well as the accessibility improvements necessary for the Park, required in the City's settlement agreement, and identified in the Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan update in progress.

arks Funding in adopted FY15/16 budget

Construction cost estimate prepared by Carducci & Associates in 2011 of \$1.2 million

Did not include:

- Cost of accessibility improvements, Planning Commission conditions of approval or price escalation
- ▶ Design services during construction (e.g, responding to Requests for Information), construction management and construction inspection

Adopt a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Sausalito Awarding, Approving a Budget Transfer for and Authorizing the City Manager to (a) Issue Notice of Award and Execute a Contract with Bauman Landscape & Construction, Inc. of San Francisco for Construction, (b) Execute an Amendment to the Existing Professional/Consulting Services Agreement with Carducci & Associates, Inc. of San Francisco for Design Services During Construction and (c) Execute a Professional/Consulting Services Contract with Riedinger Consulting, Inc. of Sausalito for Construction Management and Related Services -- all for Delivery of the of the City of Sausalito Robin Sweeny Park Improvement Project

Direct Staff to initiate a value-engineering process with the contractor, designer and construction manager to reduce the costs of both the base bid project and the bid alternates without changing appearance or reducing the scope of the improvements

Direct Staff to return to Council with Mid-Year Budget that provides funding for delivery of Alternates
