Golden Gate Bridge, Highway, and Transportation District (Applicant) City of Sausalito (Owner) Staff: Castro

DESCRIPTION: The Golden Gate Bridge, Highway, and Transportation District is proposing to demolish the existing passenger boarding systems at the Sausalito ferry landing which is east of the intersection of Bridgeway and Anchor Street (APN 065-073-05) and replace them with new passenger boarding systems. The intent of the project is to replace aging facilities, extend the life of the facilities, and improve vessel loading for all passengers by standardizing boarding operations. The proposal includes a new 145.5-foot long by 53-foot wide concrete float, a new 90-foot long by 16-foot wide steel gangway, and a new 96-foot long by 21-foot-wide pile-supported concrete pier that will extend
