# 2. ZONING ORDINANCE TEXT/MAP AMENDMENTS REGARDING EMERGENCY [HOMELESS] SHELTERS (ZOA 15-008)

City of Sausalito (Applicant)

**DESCRIPTION:** A request for a Zoning Ordinance Amendment to modify the Emergency Shelter provisions in Sausalito Municipal Code Section 10.28.080 and the Zoning Ordinance Map. On July 22, 2014, the City Council adopted Ordinance 1223 which in part established an "Emergency Shelter" Overlay Zone, which established Emergency [Homeless] Shelters as a permitted use by right in the Zone and established development and management standards for Emergency Homeless Shelters in the "Emergency Shelter" Overlay Zone. The provisions of Ordinance 1223 are required pursuant to California Government Code Sections 65582 and 65583 and 65589.5. Since its adoption, the State Department of Housing and Community Development has directed the City to make amendments to the Emergency Shelter provisions in Sausalito Municipal Code Section 10.28.080, which the City committed to making in Program 27 of the Housing Element (adopted January 13, 2015). The specific amendments committed to by the City include (1) removing the requirement that the Management Plan be "approved" by the City, (2) clarifying that a shelter operator address the services listed in the management plan to the extent such services are required by the shelter, and (3) removing the requirement for a shelter operator to provide an annual report for compliance with conditions. Additionally, the City Council's working group has recommended that the amendment also include the removal of the following two sites from the Emergency Shelter Overlay Zone: the School District site on Nevada Street and the MLK site on Coloma.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Review and make a recommendation to the City Council regarding the amendment of the Emergency Shelter provisions in the Sausalito Municipal code and Zoning Ordinance Map regarding the removal of the School District site on Nevada Street and the MLK site on Coloma from the Emergency Shelter Overlay Zone.

The public hearing was opened.

# 3. FISHER RESIDENCE / 60 EDWARDS AVENUE (DR 13-311)

**DESCRIPTION:** A request for a Design Review Permit for a 409 square foot addition to the existing 1,385 square foot residence at 60 Edwards Avenue. The proposed project will renovate an existing lower-level storage area and infill below existing deck areas to create a new bedroom, bathroom, laundry room, and a new staircase for interior access between the upper and lower levels. Additionally, 49 square feet of new deck space will be added to the existing decks to improve existing exterior staircase access and flow.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approval, subject to conditions.
