SUSPICIOUS VEHICLE INVESTIGATION RESULTS IN ARREST FOR POSSESSION OF A STOLEN VEHICLE

On Sunday, October 2, 2016, at approximately 7:40 AM, Sausalito Police Corporal Brian Mather and Officer James Fotherby observed a suspicious vehicle in the 400 block of Bridgeway. The vehicle, a 2011 Ford Flex, was parked on the roadway facing the wrong direction and a person appeared to be asleep in the driver's seat.

Corporal Mather and Officer Fotherby conducted a records check on the Ford, which revealed it had been reported stolen in Daly City on September 29, 2016. Officers conducted a high-risk stop on the Ford and arrested the driver, Shellisa Green (25 year old female from San Francisco and Santa Rosa), without incident. While searching Green and the vehicle, Officers located narcotics related paraphernalia in her possession. A warrants check on Green revealed that there was an outstanding no bail, felony warrant for her arrest out of Sonoma County.

Green was arrested for 10851 VC- Possession of a Stolen Vehicle, No Bail Felony Sonoma County Warrant for Violation of Probation and Vandalism, and 11364 HS – Possession of Narcotics Paraphernalia and was booked into the Marin County Jail.
