NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

Project Title

Bridgeway Commons Residential Condominiums

Applicant

Sy Jardin's Lookout LLC, Property Owner; Miles Berger, Architect

Location

1755 Bridgeway (APNs 064-151-02 & -03), Sausalito, CA (includes property/buildings with addresses: 1745 Bridgeway, 1751 Bridgeway, 1757 Bridgeway, and 160 Filbert Avenue)

Project Description

The Project proposes redevelopment of two parcels zoned R-3 (Multiple Family Residential) with 16 residential condominiums. All existing buildings and structures on the property would be demolished and replaced with two multi-level buildings containing the 16 condominium units (one three-bedroom and 15 two-bedroom units) and 32 on-site parking spaces contained within a parking garage. Vehicular access to the development would be provided via a 24-foot wide driveway on Bridgeway that would provide right-turn ingress and right-turn egress to and from the parking area. Driveway, sidewalk and landscaping Improvements are proposed within the public right-of-way along Bridgeway. Landscaping and public sidewalk improvements are also proposed along Filbert Avenue; however, access is proposed from Bridgeway only. The project requires approval of the following discretionary actions by the City:

- Environmental Review. The Bridgeway Commons Condominiums Initial Study / Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND), prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act. This document analyzes the potential impacts caused by the project and identifies various measures to mitigate these impacts.
- Vesting Tentative Subdivision Map. To create a condominium map for 16 residential condominiums.
- **Design Review Permit.** For demolition of existing residential buildings, and construction of two new buildings and other improvements for new condominium development.
- Tree Permit. To permit the removal of "protected" trees on the property, as defined in the City's Tree and View Ordinance.
- Encroachment Agreement. For private improvements within the public right-of-ways.

The Planning Commission will take public comments on the Initial Study / Mitigated Negative Declaration at 6:30 p.m. on **December 15, 2016**. The meeting will be held in the City of Sausalito Council Chambers, 420 Litho Street, Sausalito.
