PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Preservation Architecture, on behalf of property owners Carmela and Asriel Levin, requests an amendment to the Local Historic Register designation for the property at 168 Harrison Avenue ("Tanglewood"). The amendment includes the removal of the gardens from the Local Historic Register designation. On March 22, 2017, the Planning Commission will review the Historic Landmarks Board's recommendation on the proposed amendment and forward a recommendation to the City Council.
