1. ONLY IN SAUSALITO / 676-686 BRIDGEWAY (DR-CUP-SP-EA 16-145)
Staff: Calvin Chan

**DESCRIPTION:** McCoy Architecture, on behalf of Only in Sausalito, LLC, requests approval of the following items concerning the structure located at 676-686 Bridgeway within the Downtown Historic District:

- Design Review Permit for exterior modifications to a structure located within the Downtown Historic District;
- Conditional Use Permit for establishment of an apparel store and a candy store/desserts shop categorized as "visitor serving stores";
- Sign Permit for business identification signage;
- Variance to exceed the maximum lot coverage; and
- Encroachment Agreement for business identification blade signage, five upper-level bay windows, and entry awning.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approval, subject to conditions.

2. ICE HOUSE PLAZA PHASE II / 780 Bridgeway (DR 15-340)

**DESCRIPTION:** The Sausalito Historical Society/Sausalito Foundation requests approval of a Design Review Permit to allow the incorporation of interpretive elements to the approved plaza/public space enhancement project surrounding the Ice House located at the corner of Bridgeway and Bay Street – 780 Bridgeway.
