



CITY OF SAUSALITO NOTICE OF CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING FOR REVIEW OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE LOCAL HISTORIC REGISTER DESIGNATION FOR THE PROPERTY AT 168 HARRISON AVENUE ("TANGLEWOOD")

You are invited to attend a City Council public hearing on the following project:

PROJECT DESCRIPTION Preservation Architecture, on behalf of property owners Carmela and Asriel Levin, requests an amendment to the Local Historic Register designation for the property at 168 Harrison Avenue ("Tanglewood"). The amendment is limited to the removal of the gardens from the Local Historic Register designation. The residence and grounds would remain on the Local Historic Register designation. On May 23, 2017, the City Council will hear public testimony and review the Planning Commission and the Historic Landmarks Board's recommendations on the proposed amendment.
