As we have not been granted permitted parking as so many other streets in Sausalito have been, my husband Eric Darwin and myself, as well as our neighbors VEHEMENTLY oppose events taking place at 2200 Bridgeway until we are granted permitted parking and therefore assured that we as residents get to park before those attending events at 2200 Bridgeway. It's honestly frustrating that we're still having to fight for this. It has been an issue for years.
