


### Strategic Plan as Foundation for Budget

  - 2016-18 Strategic Resources Plan adopted
- 2017: Strategic Plan updated
  - Second year of Strategic Resources Plan
- 2018-2020 Strategic Resources Plan updated and refined
  - 2018-2020 Strategic Resources Plan adopted
- ➤ 2019-2020 Comprehensive Review and Update of Strategic Plan to coincide with General Plan update
