Arrest Made for Possession of Stolen Vehicle

On Wednesday, September 20, 2017, at approximately 9:03 AM, Sausalito Police Officers were notified by the Marin County Communications Center that there was an ALPR (Automated License Plate Reader) hit of a stolen vehicle coming into Sausalito from the 4000 block of Bridgeway. The ALPR notification was for a green Toyota Corolla with a CA license plate. Officers responded to the area to look for the vehicle.

Officer Honour Knudsen located the vehicle at the corner of Bridgeway and Litho Streets. Officers made a traffic stop on the vehicle at 1103 Bridgeway, Bridgeway Gas. The two occupants of the vehicle were taken into custody without incident.

The driver of the vehicle was identified as 26 year old Taylor Wade George out of Eureka, CA. George was arrested for taking a vehicle without the owner's consent and for possession of stolen property. The passenger of the vehicle was identified as 18 year old Zachery Cringle also out of Eureka, CA. Cringle was arrested for possession of stolen property.

Sausalito officers talked with the victim and learned that approximately two weeks prior the suspects met the victim as she was attempting to sell her vehicle. Allegedly the suspects showed up without cash and intimidated the owner to let them take it on a test drive. They took the vehicle for the test drive and never returned.

George was booked for possession of the stolen vehicle, possession of stolen property and driving on a suspended license. His bail was set at \$25,000. Cringle was booked for possession of stolen property. He bail was set at \$10,000. They were both booked into the Marin County Jail.
