Commissioner Paul Rodgers will draft an open letter to the community to post in regards to the citizen's complaints of unleashed dogs in City Parks. The Commission will also create a PR campaign in local newspapers asking resident dog owners to be considerate

of the parks and the local leash law. The Commission will invite the Sausalito Police Department and members of the Friends of the Dog Park to formulate a strategy acceptable to all.
