1. THE GATEKEEPER SCULPTURE / 19 TOYON LANE Staff: Katie Faulkner

**DESCRIPTION:** Appeal of a Zoning Administrator decision approving a Minor Use Permit to allow for the serving of beer and wine at the California Caviar Company tasting room located at 1403 Bridgeway (302 Caledonia Street, Suite 5).

**RECOMMENDATION:** Deny the appeal and uphold the Zoning Administrator's decision.

New language shall say, "Can consider modifications subject to the applicable provisions of the Sausalito Municipal Code."
