APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Approval of minutes of March 21, 2005 was tabled until next meeting.

Recreation Report Program Highlights:

Quarterly Report:

- This is the presentation of the Recreation Report not Quarterly Report.
- Quarterly Report is not yet available due to Audit.
- Continued Strong 3rd Quarter anticipated based on Program Registrations. Department is well ahead of last years Revenue at this time.

Youth Services:

Harrison Park: Still need \$20,000 for funding and Adam will work with Lion's club and architect over the course of the next few weeks. Youth Services will assist.

Langendorf: More time needed to schedule community meetings. Dog issue and review swing set setup.

Cloudview: Landscaping is done and still need to deal with accessability and placement of play equipment.

Marinship: Send request to State for approval of funds.
