SUSPICIOUS PERSON INVESTIGATON LEADS TO STOLEN BOAT ARREST

On Wednesday, October 24, 2018, at approximately 8:59 PM, Sausalito Police Officer Brandon Nail noticed Timothy Logan (a 38 year old male out of the Sacramento area) moving several pieces of property from his vehicle to a boat tied up in the area of Schoonmaker Marina.

Officer Nail's suspicious person investigation revealed that Logan was on probation out of Yolo County. A subsequent search revealed that Logan was in possession of several items of stolen property, burglary tools, narcotics and narcotics paraphernalia. Further investigation revealed the boat (a 16 foot long Triumph) Logan was placing property onto had been reported stolen out of San Joaquin County on October 10, 2018.

Logan was arrested and booked into the Marin County Jail for possession of stolen property, burglary tools, narcotics and narcotics paraphernalia.
