**NOTICE OF PLANNING COMMISSION HEARING FOR A**  
**ZONING ORDINANCE TEXT AMENDMENT REGARDING**  
**INCLUSIONARY HOUSING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Sausalito Planning Commission will hold a public hearing beginning at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, December 19, 2018 in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 420 Litho Street, Sausalito on a Zoning Ordinance Amendment regarding Inclusionary Housing [2018-00370]. The Zoning Ordinance Amendment will add a new Section 10.40.140 of the Sausalito Municipal Code to establish Inclusionary Housing regulations, which would require housing developers to include affordable income housing in new or replacement residential development projects. This amendment is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15061.b.3 of the CEQA Guidelines.

What will Happen. You can comment on the project. At the December 19, 2018 meeting the Planning Commission will consider all public testimony and decide whether or not to recommend City Council adoption of the Zoning Ordinance Amendment. The Planning Commission may also decide to continue the public hearing, or request additional information
