

NOTICE OF VACANCIES ON THE PLANNING COMMISSION AND GENERAL PLAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

PLANNING COMMISSION

Do you have professional experience in – or a personal passion for – architecture, landscape architecture, or community and economic development? If so, please consider applying for the open seat on the **Planning Commission** of the City of Sausalito. This five-member commission is responsible for reviewing applications for design review and land use entitlements, as set forth in planning and zoning laws of the City of Sausalito and the state of California. Commissioners must be Sausalito residents.

The Planning Commission also advises the City Council on zoning ordinance amendments, historic preservation, park improvements, and the General Plan Update. The commission meets on two evenings a month in the Council Chambers. Commissioners are appointed by the City Council after an interview process to assess the qualifications of applicants. New commissioners serve a three-year term, and two terms may be served before a commissioner "terms out."

GENERAL PLAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Due to an unexpected vacancy, the City of Sausalito has an open seat for a Sausalito resident on the General Plan Advisory Committee. If you are interested in helping to craft the document that sets the long-range vision for Sausalito, this is a great time to get involved. The General Plan Advisory Committee is a 13-member advisory body serving the community throughout the City's General Plan Update process. The committee has the following functions:

- Provide feedback and direction to the project consultant and City staff, with the goal of developing General Plan policies and objectives that are responsive to the community
- Provide guidance to the City Council, the Planning Commission, and relevant boards and commissions on key project deliverables and milestones
- Communicate information about the General Plan Update to community members and encourage interested parties to participate
- Make a recommendation to the Planning Commission and the City Council on the adoption of the General Plan Update

Applicants should be available to meet on a monthly basis and sometimes with more frequency, per the project schedule. Meetings typically take place on weekday evenings.
