The Travis Marina boasts a diverse customer base that includes active duty military members, retirees, veterans, authorized civilians, family members and local customers. Current offerings include a wide range of discounted options and activities available for military members including private sailing tours, facility rentals with amazing views, live music events, American Sailing Association certified training, and a venue with the charm of the San Francisco bay area. All of the aforementioned options offer recreational opportunities that military members may not have available without the support of Travis Air Force Base and the National Park Service.

The food operations of the Travis Marina continue to expand with its snack bar operation, private catering service and upcoming food kiosk on the boardwalk. Live bands and entertainment have been a mainstay at the Marina during the weekends and on holidays. Marina management has established an on-going relationship with large companies, social clubs, and individual customers to celebrate their private occasions in the marina with many customers returning time and again.

Travis Marina offers a dedicated sailing program. Our fleet currently consists of two twenty seven-foot Catalina training boats which are ideal for a Day on the Bay. Our flagship boat is a 31.5-foot Catalina with which we host sailing outings for groups up to six people. Annually, Travis Marina surges with visitors during Fleet Week, Fourth of July and New Year's events, to name a few. Scores of Travis Airmen and their families continue to enjoy these festivities with continuous positive feedback on their experience. With the addition of the proposed classes and restoration of the boat shop, increase in customer interests in sailing activities is anticipated and partnering with the Spaulding Wooden Boat Center will offer an added historical and educational experience to the marina customers. Additional recreation classes and tours of the surrounding area will be provided by the Travis AFB Outdoor Recreation department.

The restoration and renovation of buildings 665, 699, 664, 679 and landscaping will be in collaboration with the NPS and GGNRA to ensure adherence to standards, specifications and benchmarks.
