SUMMARY: Sausalito Municipal Code (SMC) Chapter 10.45 contains standards and criteria for wireless communications facilities. SMC Chapter 10.45 was last amended in 2003. An amendment of SMC Chapter 10.45 is proposed to update the standards and criteria for wireless communications facilities to comply with recent changes in Federal and State law. The Planning Commission is responsible for providing a recommendation to the City Council on amendments to the Zoning Ordinance per Sausalito Municipal Code Section 10.80.070.C and California Government Code Section 65855. The adoption of the Zoning Ordinance text amendment is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends that the Planning Commission recommend adoption of the Zoning Ordinance Amendment (Wireless Communications Facilities Standards and Criteria Update) to the City Council.
