CITY OF SAUSALITO NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR A ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO ADOPT MARIJUANA REGULATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sausalito City Council will hold a public hearing beginning at **7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 8, 2019** in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 420 Litho Street, Sausalito on the project described below:

The City Council of the City of Sausalito previously adopted an interim urgency Marijuana Ordinance on November 28, 2017 and is effective through November 24, 2019. The current marijuana regulations allow for the delivery of medical and recreational marijuana into Sausalito; other commercial activity such as retail sales, dispensaries, and distribution centers are prohibited. Prior to the expiration of the interim urgency ordinance on November 24, 2019, the City desires to re-adopt the existing marijuana regulations (Sausalito Municipal Code Chapter 10.47). Adoption of the current regulations will ensure continued compliance with State Law while additional analysis of potential amendments is studied.

The adoption of the Zoning Ordinance text amendment is Categorically Exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) as it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

The draft Zoning Ordinance Amendment may be reviewed during business hours at the Community Development Department, 420 Litho Street, Sausalito, between 8:00 AM and 4:30 PM on Monday through Thursday and 8:00 AM and 12:00 PM on Friday. The Staff Report will be available at the City's website (Sausalito.gov) on the Friday preceding the public hearing. Interested parties are invited to attend the hearing and/or present written testimony at or before the hearing. If you cannot attend, you can send a letter to Calvin Chan at CChan@sausalito.gov, City of Sausalito, City Hall, 420 Litho Street, Sausalito, CA 94965. You can also hand deliver a letter to the Community Development Department prior to the public hearing. Materials submitted after the distribution of the agenda packets will be available for public review at the Community Development Department during normal business hours, at the City Council meeting, and on the City's Website (subject to Staff's ability to post the documents prior to the meeting).
