DECLARATION OF HEIDI SCOBLE

I, Heidi Scoble, declare as follows:

- 1. I am the City Clerk for the City of Sausalito and have held that position since January 2020. If called as a witness, I could and would competently testify to all facts stated herein based upon my personal knowledge except where stated upon information and belief. This Declaration is submitted in support of Defendants' Opposition to Plaintiffs' Ex Parte Application for Temporary Restraining Order.
- 2. On February 5, 2021, a Special Meeting of the Sausalito City Council was conducted telephonically through Zoom and broadcast live on the City's Website ("February 5th Special Meeting").
- At the February 5th Special Meeting, the City Council voted 4-1 to approve two 3. resolutions regarding homelessness in Sausalito and the tent encampment at Dunphy Park. The vote came after a 3.5-hour meeting during which nearly 40 speakers gave public comment. A true and correct copy of Resolution No. 6008 re: Exploring Housing Opportunities is attached to Defendants' Index of Exhibits as Exhibit 1. A true and correct copy of Resolution No. 6009 re: Homeless Encampments is attached to Defendants' Index of Exhibits as Exhibit 2. A true and correct copy of Attachment A to the second Resolution re: Homeless Encampments is attached to Defendants' Index of Exhibits as Exhibit 2a.
- 4. The second Resolution re: Homeless Encampments was modified by the meeting minutes to specify that individuals would not be moved from Dunphy Park to Marinship Park until reasonable storage facilities, such as storage lockers, were in place at Marinship Park. A true and correct copy of the February 5th Special Meeting Minutes will be provided to the Court as Exhibit 3 to Defendants' Index of Exhibits (reserved) once available.
