PROJECT SUMMARY: The project includes the installation of new striping on Nevada Street to install a two way bike path on the North side of Nevada Street from Bridgeway to Buchanan Drive. The project will require the elimination of parking on the North side of Nevada Street. While this project has been discussed several times at the Pedestrian Bicycle Advisory Committee, staff is interested in holding an additional public meeting opportunity for the public to voice their opinions of the project. Staff is seeking input from the Planning Commission on whether this project should proceed to the construction phase.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN: The Planning Commission will conduct a Study Session on the Nevada Street Striping Pilot Project and accept all public testimony, offer input, observations, and comments on the project, and provide a recommendation to staff.
