Defendants’ Motion to Modify Preliminary Injunction came on for hearing before the Hon. Judge Edward M. Chen on April 29, 2021 in Courtroom 5 of the above-captioned court.

Having considered the papers, evidence, and arguments of the parties, and good cause appearing, Defendants’ Motion is

GRANTED AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Part (2) of the preliminary injunction issued March 1, 2021, enjoining Defendants and those acting in concert with them from “closing and/or clearing the Dunphy Park encampment,” is dissolved.

2. Defendants and those acting in concert with them are not enjoined from relocating the encampment from Dunphy Park to Marinship Park.
