Response to Prospective Bidder's Questions:

Question 1:

- a. Will the homeless encampment be removed before we mobilize to the site? The encampment represents a health and safety risk to our workers and the residents of the encampment.

Response 1:

- a. At this time it is not known if the encampment will be relocated prior to mobilization to the site.

Question 2:

- a. For Bid Item Number 8 - CA Hazardous Waste Transportation and Disposal – Will the City allow onsite stabilization of metals and disposal of the soil as non-hazardous at a Class II or Class III landfill?

Response 2:

- a. Attention is drawn to Section 9. Value Engineer of the Special Conditions.

Question 3:

- a. Can you provide a list of all required City permits for the project and what fees the contractor should expect to pay? Will the City provide any and all required drawings and engineering support to obtain the permits?

Response 3:

- a. The City of Sausalito will require that the contractor awarded the work obtain an encroachment permit and grading permit. There will be no fees associated with either of these permits. The contractor is required to submit and obtain approval of drawings for these permits, which may include but not be limited to traffic control plans and erosion and sediment control plans. The City will not provide any and all required drawings or engineering support to obtain these permits.
