DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

The statistics for the Third Quarter of 2020 are reflective of the COVID-19 pandemic and the resulting lower numbers in most crimes and total calls for service.

Dispatch enters COVID/SIP complaints primarily as Miscellaneous Service Calls (MS). From July 1 through September 30, 59 MS calls were dispatched. Of those 59 calls, 29 were reports of possible COVID/SIP violations.
