The motion was unanimously approved by a voice vote. 27 28 **BUSINESS ITEMS** 29 30 A. Receive update on progress on the Public Safety Facilities project and take appropriate action as needed, including authorizing the City Manager to 31 32 execute an agreement(s) for the removal of underground storage tanks 33 34 Loren Umbertis, Project Manager for the Public Safety Facilities Project presented an 35 update on the project. He noted that on the Fire Department site, four underground storage tanks had been discovered; further noting that all involved were previously 36 37 unaware of the existence of these tanks. 38 39 Mr. Umbertis reported that work was immediately stopped in that area and they 40 contacted a tank removal company for assistance. He noted that all liquids were 41 immediately removed. Mr. Umbertis reported that there were three 1,000 gallon tanks and one 500 gallon tank; that two of the tanks were filled with concrete, while the other 42 43 two had water and fuel residue. 44 45 Mr. Umbertis further reported that the tanks would now need to be removed. Mr. Umbertis advised that the cost to remove the fluids would be approximately \$2,000 and 46 removal of the tanks would be approximately \$18,000. Mr. Umbertis further advised 47 48 Council that there would be a need for an environmental geotechnical consultant, who 49 was already on board, to test the soils at a cost of approximately \$8,000 to \$10,000.
