

YOU ARE INVITED TO ATTEND A COMMUNITY FORUM REGARDING OUTDOOR DINING AND ACTIVITIES IN SAUSALITO

As the State of California has fully reopened its economy, Sausalito residents and businesses are looking forward to shaping and reshaping their futures after the devastating impacts of COVID-19. Please join us for a virtual community forum on **Wednesday June 30** beginning at **6:00pm** to discuss the future of outdoor dining and activities in the City. The purpose of the forum is to receive community feedback on approaches to transitioning out of shelter-in-place and allow businesses to rebound and thrive while also making our streets and sidewalks a place for everyone to enjoy. The focus of the forum will be on three topics:

- The temporary outdoor activities agreements issued by the City during the pandemic, and how they should be phased out over time to allow for our local economy to rebound;
- The pilot program to close a portion of Caledonia Street for outdoor dining, and if it should continue permanently in some fashion; and
- The temporary parklet permits issued by the City during the pandemic, how they should be phased out over time, or transformed into a permanent part of Sausalito.
