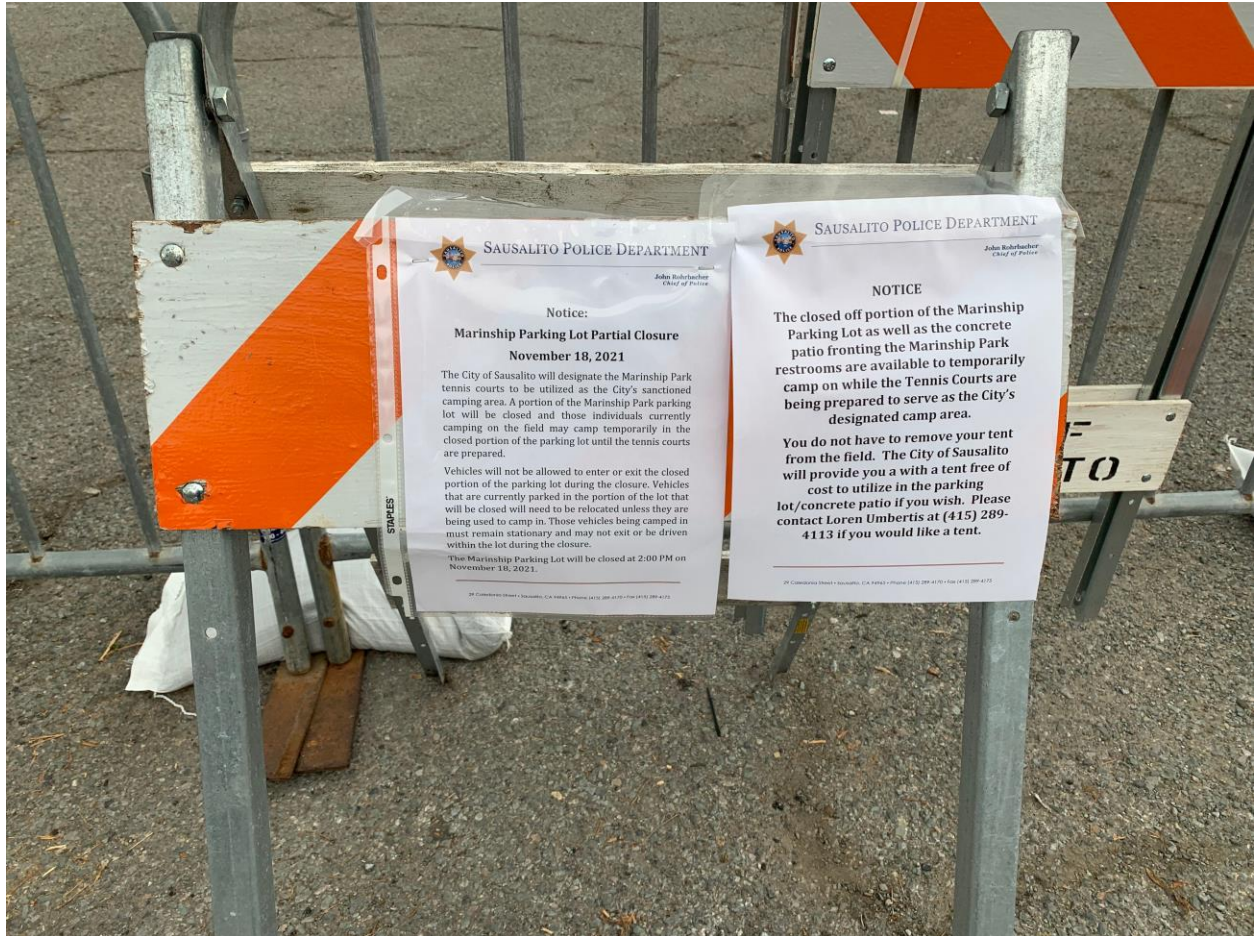

The City of Sausalito will designate the Marinship Park tennis courts to be utilized as the City's sanctioned camping area. A portion of the Marinship Park parking lot will be closed and those individuals currently camping on the field may camp temporarily in the closed portion of the parking lot until the tennis courts are prepared.

Vehicles will not be allowed to enter or exit the closed portion of the parking lot during the closure. Vehicles that are currently parked in the portion of the lot that will be closed will need to be relocated unless they are being used to camp in. Those vehicles being camped in must remain stationary and may not exit or be driven within the lot during the closure.

The Marinship Parking Lot will be closed at 2:00 PM on November 18, 2021.



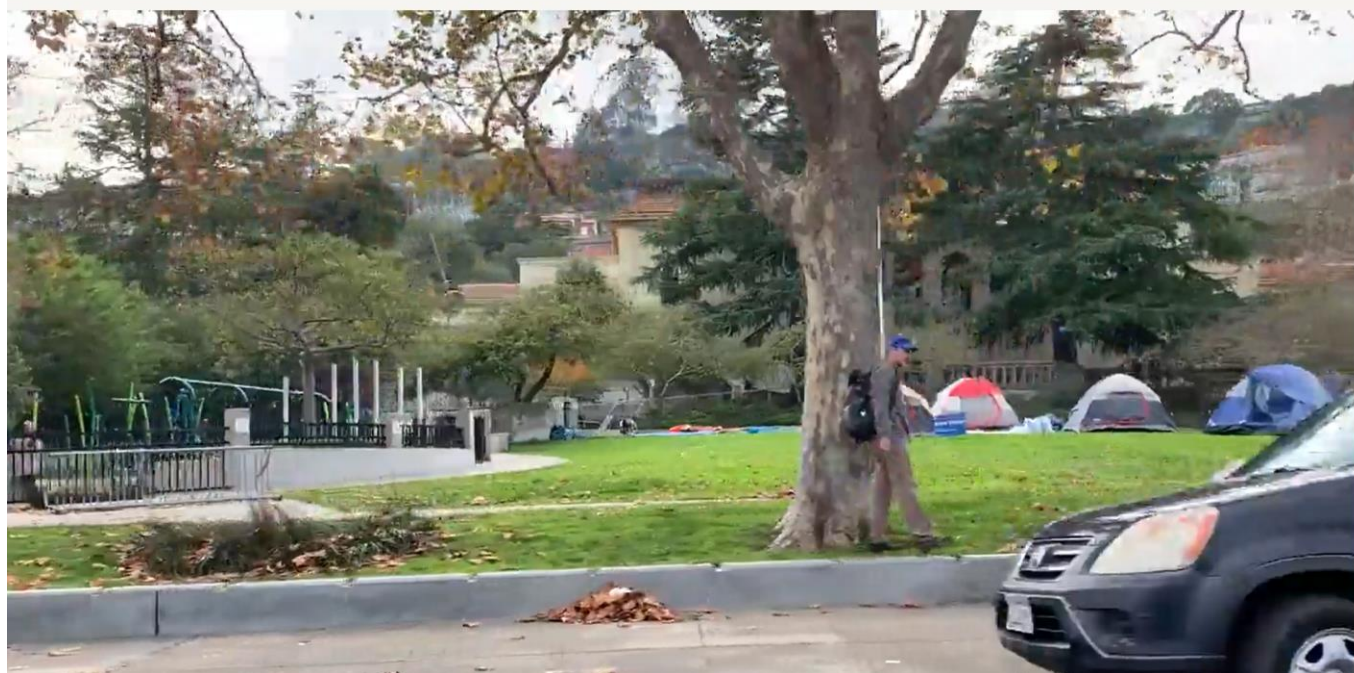
