This is to inform you that in regards to the hearing set for November 10, 2021 on the Temporary Restraining Order prohibiting the destruction of the storage shed at the Marinship Park encampment, the parties have reached an agreement that was essentially concluded just before your Order.

The parties will attempt resolution of the matter with the assistance of Judge Illman and have agreed the City will not remove or dismantle the shed so long as it used only as a storage facility.
