PROJECT SUMMARY: Conditional Use Permit project request to convert an existing three-story office building into a 12-unit residential building (2021-00110), including full interior remodel, exterior finishes, window and doors, a parking reduction request from 21 existing parking spaces to 18 parking spaces, a bonus density for 8 base units and 4 bonus units, and a development standard waiver to allow two units to be located on the ground floor.
