PROJECT SUMMARY: Applicant Matt Ininns and Owner Max Houtzager are requesting approval of a Design Review Permit at 265 Gate 5 Road to demolish an existing one-story commercial art studio and remove existing sheds and shipping containers and construct four one- and two-story interconnected structures with roof decks. The project would accommodate art studios, exhibition space, and gathering spaces. Total floor area would be less than 10,000 S.F.

CEQA DETERMINATION: Categorially Exempt under Section 15303 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines.
