PROJECT SUMMARY: Applicant, Arterberry Design, on behalf of Teji Johal, is requesting the approval of a Design Permit for exterior renovations and the addition of approximately 578 sq.ft. of floor area to upper floor of the upper unit, alteration of the roof profile and addition of a balcony to upper floor. Encroachment Agreement and Nonconformity Permit required for proposed project. The project has been determined to be exempt from further environmental review under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

WHAT WILL HAPPEN: The Planning Commission will consider all public testimony and decide whether to approve, modify, or deny the project.
