Annual Military Equipment Use Report

Summary of currently owned military equipment:

- 1 Colt AR-15 SRD 556 Rifle and 1 SRD 556 Rifle Suppressor
- 6 Remington 870 Less Lethal Shotguns and 240 bean bag rounds

Equipment used in the line of duty by Sausalito Police in 2022/2023:

- None of the Sausalito Police Department's military equipment was used the line of duty in 2022/2023

Equipment used in training by Sausalito Police in 2022/2023:

- 01/2023, Remington Less Lethal Shotguns and bean bag rounds, 60 rounds used. This training was an annual qualification for in-service officers as well as two newly hired officers.
- 06/2023, Remington Less Lethal Shotgun and bean bag rounds, 15 rounds used. This training was a qualification for a newly hired officer.

Total Annual Cost and Source of Funds:

- 75 bean bag rounds were used in 2022/2023 for training at a cost of \$468.00.
- There were no additional costs associated with the maintenance, transportation, or storage of the military equipment.
- No other equipment was purchased in 2022/2023.
- Source of funds is the General Fund

Complaints or Concerns Addressed to Sausalito Police:

- No emails or letters were received from the community with concerns or complaints about the military equipment.
