PROJECT SUMMARY: The applicant, Ted Horton, on behalf of owner, SASP LLC, requests Planning Commission approval of a Tree Removal Permit to allow the removal of two (2) heritage trees; one (1) Victorian Box (*Pittosporum undulatum*) at 86 San Carlos Avenue (APN: 065-164-10), and one (1) Coast Live Oak (*Quercus agrifolia*) at 31 Harrison Avenue (APN: 065-164-11). The project has been determined to be exempt from further environmental review under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15304.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN: The Planning Commission will consider all public testimony and decide whether to approve as requested or conditioned, modify, or deny the project.
