PROJECT SUMMARY: Lew D Barber, property owner, is requesting a Historic Resource Determination for the property located at 302 Fourth Street, a single family residence. The Commission is charged with reviewing the historic evaluations prepared by the applicants and the City's consulting historic architects and providing a determination as to whether the structure may qualify as an historic resource under the CEQA guidelines.

CEQA DETERMINATION: Per the Public Resources Code, Section 21084.1 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations Section 15064.5 the City is required to consider if an older property qualifies as an historic resource under CEQA.

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HOW TO COMMENT: All persons are welcome to comment on the project. You can comment on the project via email to the project contact. The deadline to submit written comments is by **12:00 PM on Thursday, June 20, 2024**. You may also comment orally during the hearing.
