Overview of Bid Solicitation

 - <u>Good Faith Efforts Documentation.</u> Each bidder shall provide Attachment I for sufficient steps taken to identify and select DBE/SBE subcontractors/subconsultants/suppliers to be included in this Contract. Include the *DBE/SBE Confirmation of Participation in Contract* form.
 - Proof of DBE/SBE Certification. Firms must be DBE/SBE certified at the time of bid submittal. See page 138-139 for acceptable comparable SBE certifications. To locate DBE/SBE certified firms, see Section S11.03 for resources and use the *Guide for Searching DBE/SBE Firms* included in this packet. Where applicable, bidders must also submit a *Small Business Affidavit of Size* (Attachment H) from each SBE subcontractor/subconsultant/supplier for this contract.



- > Click: Finished




