PROJECT SUMMARY: Applicant, Pete Petri, on behalf of Owner, Loron Investments, is requesting a Certificate of Appropriateness to facilitate the exterior repainting of the historic Hotel Sausalito & Suites hotel at 16 El Portal Street (APN: 065-133-17) in the Downtown Historic Overlay District. This project is determined to be Categorically Exempt for environmental review Per Section 15331 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as the scope of work is determined to be consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Treatment of Historic Properties.
