PROJECT SUMMARY: Applicant, Tessa White, on behalf of Owner, Daniel Morgan, is requesting approval of a Conditional Use Permit application to change the existing land use from a restaurant land use (with dedicated off-street parking) to a Recreation and Fitness Center land use for the establishment of a children's indoor playground business at 2650 Bridgeway Boulevard (APN: 063-140-18). The project has been determined to be exempt from further environmental review under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Sections 15301.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN: The Planning Commission will consider all public testimony and decide whether to approve as requested or conditioned, modify, or deny the project.
