Award of a Purchase Order to W.R. Forde Associates for Budgeted Minor Public Work Sewer Repairs

RECOMMENDED MOTION

Adopt a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Sausalito Finding the Project Categorically Exempt from CEQA and Awarding a Purchase Order to W.R. Forde Associates for Budgeted Minor Public Work Sewer Repairs in an Amount not to Exceed \$22,565

SUMMARY

The following repair/replacement of a private side sewer lateral in the City of Sausalito has been identified as necessary by the Department of Public Works Director and the Sewer System Coordinator:

- Replace approximately 66' of recently installed 6" C-900 pipeline serving 1403 Bridgeway (formerly known as Peter Pan Doughnut Shop). Currently under construction to become Amy's Cafe
- Prior (Feb 01, 2006 City of Sausalito Construction Permit Application P11800 issued by Ms. Gayle Drake on behalf of CDD Director Paul Kermoyan) City of Sausalito inspection (Feb 27, 2006) allowed the line to be installed incorrectly creating a major reverse grade situation.
- Install 2 new manholes (approx 3' deep and 7 feet deep). 1 on Locust Street in the middle of the roadway between addresses 327 Locust Street and 1403 Bridgeway to improve the substandard grade affecting the existing private side sewer lateral.)
- One of the above cited manholes will create access to the sanitary sewer line on Locust between Caledonia Avenue and Bridgeway providing an accessible tie-in point for the 1403 Bridgeway lateral replacement. The Locust Street sanitary sewer line has never been maintained by City of Sausalito Crews. For all practical purposes it is in the public right of way and has no record of ever being maintained. The City of Sausalito should take the lead to maintain this sytem item
- The other man hole to be installed will be installed on 1403 Bridgeway property. This manhole will provide appropriate access to the pre-existing, active 6" and 4" sewer lines serving the 1403 Bridgeway commercial complex. This manhole will also be the point where the wastewater leaving the complex will be conveyed to the newly

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installed sanitary sewer manhole on Locust Street. The portion of to-be installed new 6" lateral and its connection to the Locust Street sanitary sewer (when the new sewer alignment and construction are complete) will be the responsibility of the 1403 Bridgeway property owner Mr. Kia Zandvakili.

Procurement by Purchase Order conforms with Sausalito Municipal Code section 3.30.320, "Negotiate contract or purchase order procedures." The code section is as follows: "(f)or those projects qualifying under subsection A of Section 3.30.310, the applicable department head shall obtain a cost estimate from the project engineer or architect prior to issuing a purchase order or negotiating a contract with a responsible contractor. For any City force account work, the department head shall first comply with the guidelines established by the California Uniform Construction Cost Accounting Commission in determining the cost of the public work. The City Manager shall have the authority to award and to execute any contract for the public work qualifying under subsection A of Section 3.30.310 in an amount up to and including \$15,000 and City Council approval shall be required for any contract exceeding \$15,000. The current limits for such procurements are provided in the attached document issued by the California State Controller as of April 29, 2005 – the limit for negotiated contract or purchase order is \$30,000¹.

Having estimated the value of the work at \$30,000, issued the attached request and having received responsible and responsive quotations from North Bay Construction, Inc., Linscott Engineering Contractors, Inc. and W.R. Forde Associates, Staff recommends that a purchase order be awarded to the lowest of those, W. R. Forde Associates for \$22,565. The next highest quotation received was \$26,790.

BACKGROUND

Much of the Sanitary Sewer System serving the City is old. From time to time deteriorated segments require repairs to prevent overflows and to eliminate obstructions limiting capacity and preventing routine maintenance. The City manages these problems by allocating resources for "STOP" repairs, manhole repairs and manhole installations. Sewer "STOP" damage can include but is not limited to specific forms of damage such as small collapsed sewer segments, sewer lateral intrusion, large obstructions, sewer segment joint offsets, sags resulting in excessive accumulation of sewage debris. The problems are generally small and isolated problems. Repairs of these problems are needed to prevent overflows (and resultant illegal discharges to waters of the State and waters of the U.S. waters) and to enable routine maintenance (rodding or jetting) to be performed.

The subject item addresses a problem site as follows:

- Work to be conducted on Locust Street in the middle of the roadway between addresses 327 Locust Street and 1403 Bridgeway working from South to North toward 1403 Bridgeway.
- This project will improve the substandard grade affecting the existing private side sewer lateral serving 1403 Bridgeway that the City of Sausalito recently signed off on as appropriately configured.
- Additionally The project creates a window of opportunity for the City of Sausalito to replace 66' of pipe line and install integral manholes for on-going maintenance needs
- Lastly the previously installed, reverse grade sewer lateral will be disconnected from the sanitary sewer and appropriately abandoned

ISSUES

The recommended work will reduce the potential for public sewer overflows, and therefore reduce the potential for damage to public and private property or pollution of the waters of the US that are the subject of a November 24, 2008 Notice of Violation and Order for Compliance issued by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

The proposed work is categorically exempt from CEQA² under Section 15301 of the State CEQA Guidelines,³ Existing Facilities, where the work consists of the, "…repair, maintenance, …or minor alteration of the existing public structures, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination."

Because the project involves repair of existing facilities consistent with the manhole/line stop project found to conform to the General Plan in compliance with California Government Code section 65401 at the Planning Commission of the City of Sausalito's August 13, 2008 meeting, no further action on the part of the Planning Commission is warranted.

The quotations received were based on discussion of the problem by City Staff to the proposing contractors, a physical inspection of the repair sites and the contractors' experience with previous similar work. Because the work is underground, field conditions are not fully known. There is a potential to discover conditions not contemplated which could add costs to the work. As such, the bid is not a lump sum bid. It is a not to exceed without additional authorization quotation. The discovery of unexpected conditions could lead to the need for additional work. No such work will be performed without additional authorization

FISCAL IMPACT

The funding requested is \$22,565. Said funding is available in the adopted Sewer Fund budget, account number 110-550-400-450. As of July 1, 2009 \$968,200 was available in that account.

In conformance with Sausalito Municipal Code (SMC) section 3.30.310 (A), a Public Work project of \$30,000 or less may be performed by force account, negotiated contract or purchase order in conformance with Sausalito Municipal Code section 3.30.330, Council approval is required for any such contract exceeding \$15,000.

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Adopt Resolution No. _____ of the City Council of the City of Sausalito Finding the Project Categorically Exempt from CEQA and Awarding a Purchase Order to W.R. 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RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAUSALITO AWARDING A NEGOTIATED CONTRACT TO AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER WITH W.R. FORDE ASSOCIATES FOR IMMEDIATE NEEDS SEWER REPAIRS

WHEREAS, with action of June 23, 2009 the City Council adopted the 2009-20010 Annual Budget which includes funding to construct Sewer Rehabilitation Capital Improvements in the amount of \$968,200; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and Sewer System Coordinator have identified and prioritized certain and Immediate Needs Sewer Repairs the details of which are described in the attached Staff Report; and

WHEREAS, such repairs are categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act as provided for by Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Chapter 3, Article 19, Section 15301; and

WHEREAS, such repairs were found to conform to the Sausalito General Plan by Planning Commission action of August 13, 2008 in conformance with California Government Code section 65401; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with Article 3, Section 3.30.320 of the Sausalito Municipal Code the City Engineer has estimated the cost of said repairs at \$30,000; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with Article 3, Section 3.30.320 of the Sausalito Municipal Code the Sewer System Coordinator has solicited quotations from three responsible contractors for performance of said repairs, and

WHEREAS, the City received and the Director of Public Works evaluated three responses, and recommends award to W.R. Forde of Richmond, California for the lump sum of \$22,565.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sausalito:

- 1. Awards a Negotiated Contract to W.R. Forde for the services described on the attached for a lump sum of \$22,565.
- 2. Authorizes the City Manager to issue a Purchase Order to said effect on behalf of the City.

TO ALL LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENTITIES WHO HAVE OPTED INTO THE UNIFORM PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION COST ACCOUNTING ACT:

I am pleased to announce that the informal bid limits listed in Public Contract Code (PCC) sections 22032 and 22034 have been changed as follows:

- PCC section 22032 (a): Increase monetary limit from \$25,000 to \$30,000.
- PCC section 22032 (b): Increase monetary limit from \$100,000 to \$125,000.
- PCC section 22032 (c): Increase monetary limit from \$100,000 to \$125,000.
- PCC section 22034 (f): Increase monetary limit from \$100,000 to \$125,000 and the exclusion from \$110,000 to \$137,500.

Public Contract Code section 22020 states that any adjustment shall be effective beginning with the fiscal year which commences no less than 60 days following the Controller's notification to affected public agencies of the adjustment. Therefore, the above adjusted informal bid limits will be effective on July 1, 2005.
