Subject: Department Summary Report for 2009 and Goals for 2010

1. Highlights and Accomplishments:

- Completed the Customer Service pamphlet that outlines the Department's services, vision, and mission.
- Increased bicycle violation enforcement resulting in 225 citations and fewer bicycle collisions.
- Improved rental bike traffic coordination with the new signage, bike racks, and partnership with rental bike companies.
- Increased Field Interview contacts with suspicious persons.
- Provided Disaster Management training to the Management team. Set up the EOC and performed a disaster exercise.
- Completed the Fixtures, Furniture, and Equipment (FF&E) assessment for the new PD building.
- Identified and assigned specific action plans for all known preparations to move in to the new PD building (see Team Building Workshop Summary for details).
- Conducted a review of the entire Department's critical equipment for planning replacement or upgrades.
- Purchased another "green" Hybrid vehicle to enhance our fleet to 4 Hybrids.
- Hired a new Captain.
- Implemented the "Two Police Divisions Structure" for greater focus on Patrol and Support Service management (see Organizational Chart).
- Started a Reserve Police Officers program and currently have two reserve officers in training.
- Expanded lobby hours from 4 days a week to 5 days a week for improved customer convenience and service.
- Enhanced public outreach and communications with the use of Twitter, Crimereports.com, and updates to the City's Website.
- Maintained and enhanced our Department's positive culture for teamwork, quality law enforcement, and exceptional customer service.
- Secured funding and approval for 3 in-car video cameras to be installed in May 2010.
- Purchased two replacement patrol cars and one replacement unmarked car.

2. Budget Status, Trends, Forecast, Needs, and Revenue Resources:

- Currently operating within the Department's budget allotment.
- Completed operational contingency plans for continuing most core police functions and services in the event of a severe budget shortage.
- Was awarded the 2010 State of California COPS grant for \$100,000.
- PERS pension costs are projected to increase.
- Projecting an increased funding need next fiscal year to effectively operate, maintain, and equip the new PD building. The savings of rent from the PD trailers could be used to off-set these expenses.
- The Department's current budget is estimated to meet all normal staffing and operational needs for the remainder of this fiscal year.

3. Priorities, Goals, and Projects in 2010:

- Fill succession plan vacancies due to Lieutenant Pat Armitage's retirement by June 2010. Possible selections for a new police commander, sergeant, and corporal.
- Succession plan for Chief Paulin's retirement by December 2010.
- Work with the Fire Department to publicize the CERT block captain system.
- Provide support services for new Disaster Committee.
- Occupy the new PD building and become fully operational with all the new policy changes by May 31, 2010.
- Help facilitate planning for the replacement of the Parking Booth in Lot 1.
- Help facilitate the start of a comprehensive parking plan for all lots and metered areas. The main goals will be parking lot layouts and parking meter equipment upgrades that will modernize and maximize current parking areas.
- Implement a more structured and informative patrol briefing format to enhance internal communication and crime targeting strategies.
- Replace at least 1 parking enforcement vehicle.
- Increase current training hours through no, or minimal, cost training classes.
