Status Update on Vacancies on the Various City Boards and Commissions

### **SUMMARY**

This report is being presented as an informational item so that Council is advised of the upcoming vacancies which will be occurring on the various Boards and Commissions during 2010.

Attached you will find a list of the appointed Boards and Commissions along with the noted expiring terms occurring during 2010. This list has been prepared in the form of a public notice, as the City Clerk's Office is required to post such a notice annually. This public notice is mandated in order to make our residents aware of, and encourage them to apply for, positions on the various Council-appointed Boards and Commissions.

During the last few years, not only has Council been attempting to fill the annual vacancies, but has also been trying to "catch-up" on pre-existing appointments. Because of this, on October 21, 2008, Council prioritized recruiting and appointing of the various Boards and Commissions based on the number of vacancies on the Board, the type of decision-making of that Board, and how often the Board met. In 2009, the Mayor re-visited that priority list and modified it accordingly. Council has nearly completed the "catch-up" appointments.

Having that task nearly completed, staff believes that Council can return to their annual appointment schedule. With an aggressive schedule, Council could proceed with recruitment, interviews and appointments as follows:
