Following the announcements of nominations, the Mayor shall then receive public comment, and proceed on to a roll call vote. Each Councilmember may vote for one nominee per position. To be appointed, a nominee must receive at least three votes. If no nominee receives three votes, the roll call vote shall continue until the vacancy is filled. The appointment shall then be announced; or the Mayor may request staff to continue to recruit for additional applicants.
