SUMMARY

Housing Element Committee (HEC) Goals

Attachment 1 shows two alternative HEC goals distributed at the September 27, 2010 HEC meeting. Due to the lack of a quorum at the September 27 HEC meeting the goals have not been approved by the HEC. The HEC will be holding a special meeting to discuss and take action on the HEC goals prior to the October 5 City Council meeting. Staff will provide an oral update at the October 5 Council meeting regarding the HEC goals.

Community Workshop

On August 23, 2010 the HEC established Saturday, October 16 as the date for the first community workshop on the Housing Element Update. On September 28, 2010 the City Council received a Status Report from Staff regarding the workshop and discussed the scheduling of the workshop. **Attachment 2** is a draft agenda for the workshop. The HEC will discuss the agenda for the workshop at the special HEC meeting and Staff will update the Council at the October 5 meeting if the workshop agenda was refined by the HEC.

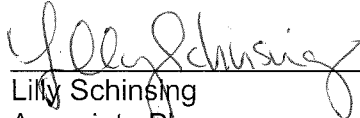

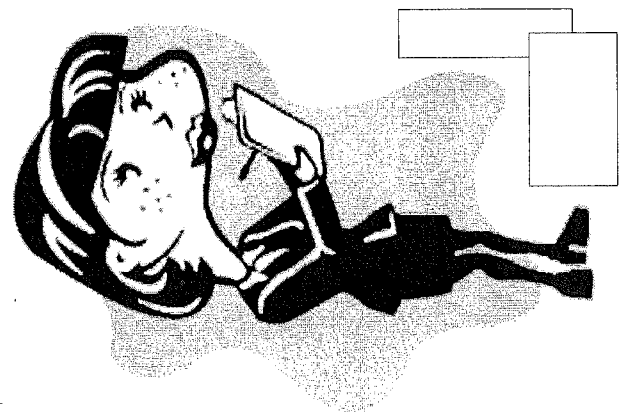
To create a housing element by 2011 that addresses Sausalito's state-mandated housing quota of 372 units ...

- ✓ Without generating adverse impact to Sausalito neighborhoods' quality of life (e.g., parking, density, scale, aesthetics).

If HEC is unsuccessful in reaching the state-mandated housing quota of 372 units through the strategies outlined above, HEC will revisit HCD and ABAG regarding the changes Sausalito has experienced in this Great Recession, and HEC may pursue self-certification.
