- Addition of 5 feet to the existing deck, the addition will create a deck that is 15 feet by 28 feet.
- Addition of a new 391 square foot, single car garage, largely constructed below grade designed to match the existing.
- Addition of two terraced retaining walls, to support the proposed garage, designed to be concrete with cement plaster surfacing to match the existing.

A Notice of Decision will be available no earlier than 5:00 pm, **Monday, November 1, 2010**. NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that if you challenge in court this Administrative Design Review Permit, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised in written correspondence delivered to the Community Development Department within ten (10) calendar days of a decision (Government Code Section 65009b2).
